Scripture Passage: 2 Kings 22:1-13; 23:1-3; 21-23

- 1. What are some reasons why people own a Bible but never read it?**
- 2. Discuss what may be hindering you from reading your Bible on a daily basis.**
- 3. What are some changes you need to make in order to put your daily Bible reading higher on your priority list?**
- 4. Discuss John 14:36. What are some examples that the Holy Spirit has used God's Word to speak to you?**
- 5. Discuss Hebrews 4:12 and James 1:5. How has God used conviction in your life to lead you to inquire of Him?**
- 6. Read Ephesians 4:22-24. Most passages in Scripture that tell us to put off some sinful behavior also tell us a new righteous behavior to put on its place. Can you find examples in Scripture and discuss?**
- 7. How does the knowledge that God's ultimate purpose of reforming you into the likeness of His Son, encourage you?**
- 8. What, if anything, did you find most interesting about the story of King Josiah?**
