4. Have you ever had a time in your life where you almost died? If so, how did it impact your relationship with God?
5. Why do we struggle to live each day like we might die tomorrow? Any suggestions on how to live like we're dying?
6. Biblically, how can we battle pride in our lives? (Prov. 13:10; 1 Peter 5:5, 6; James 4:6-10)
7. How can our pride affect the lives of future generations?
8. What are some outside pressures we face today?
9. How can we Biblically deal with outside pressures?
10. Why are lies so powerful?
11. What is the focus of the prayer found in Isaiah 37:14-20?
12. What is keeping you from trusting God with every area of your life?
