Sermon Title: FAITHBOOK: DAVID—*Walking with Integrity of Heart*

Scripture Passage: 1 Samuel 24; 1 Kings 9:4; 1 Chronicles 29:17

1. Who do you know that you would describe as a person of integrity? What sets this person apart from other people?
2. If people who know you were asked to describe you with five words, would integrity be one of them? Why or why not?
3. Have you determined to walk with integrity of heart? What can you do to improve your integrity?
4. Discuss the following quote by John Maxwell. *Integrity welds what we say, think and do, into a whole person so that permission is never granted for one of these to be out of sync.*
5. Consider the following verses: Psalm 25:21; Proverbs 2:7-8; 10:9; 11:3; 13:6. How can integrity protect us?
6. Read Matthew 23:25-28. Discuss how these words from Jesus relate to our conversation on integrity.
7. Read Job 2:1-10. Talk about the cost of choosing to live a life of integrity, even when it's not popular.
8. Talk about the statement: *I'm a Christian, and it's the right thing to do.* What types of things does a statement like this communicate to someone?
