



## Discussion Questions

**Date:** Sunday, July 25, 2010

**Sermon Title:** FAITHBOOK: NAAMAN—*In Search of a Cure*

**Scripture Passage:** 2 Kings 5:1-14; 2 Corinthians 5:21

1. Spend some time sharing personal salvation testimonies and praising God for His salvation.
2. Discuss some views that you have heard regarding sin.
3. Read James 1:14-15. Discuss what implications James' description of sin has on your own view of sin.
4. Even as Christians, sin separates relationships. How has the separation sin brings affected your relationships with others?
5. Naaman was a pretty “good guy” and successful in his land. This seems to have been a factor in his initial rejection of God's provision for healing. In what way, if any, does this resemble you before you accepted Christ? Does it still resemble you at times during your Christian walk?
6. Read Romans 8:3, 4, Galatians 3:13, and 2 Corinthians 5:21. How do these verses help you to better understand what Jesus did on the cross?
7. For any in this group who have still not made a commitment to Christ as their personal Savior, would you be ready to take that step now?
8. Spend some time praying for any persons that you know who do not have a relationship with God and are still separated from Him.
